

Arts Council of White Lake Gallery Exhibition Application

The Arts Council of White Lake is seeking concepts for art exhibitions in the Byam-Terryberry Exhibit Room at the Nuveen Center .

Please read the instructions below carefully to learn the best approach to a successful application.

Who Should Apply

The Byam-Terryberry Exhibit Room is a small exhibition space, defined by movable walls, in the Nuveen Center. The Nuveen Center is the home of the Arts Council of White Lake, a 32-year old non-profit 501(c)3. We provide numerous opportunities for the White Lake community and surrounding cities to view, listen to, create and learn from the arts, and we give support and encouragement to artists and arts organizations. The Nuveen Center holds events, fundraisers, and classes. We suggest the space to be used for solo exhibitions, but other applications and concepts will also be reviewed. Selected artists must be available to attend the exhibit reception and other events surrounding the exhibition.

About the Exhibit Space

This space is approximately 12' x 20' with 6 feet of vertical space. The gallery is lit with track lights. Most wall hanging are installed using the walker system, but alternate hanging methods can be discussed. Pedestals of various sizes are available.

The Nuveen Center is located at 106 E. Colby Street, Whitehall MI. The Arts Council serves as a hub and promoter for the arts in the White Lake area. The space also houses two classrooms, one of which doubles as a youth exhibit space. The Gallery is divided into two spaces one for member artists and the Byam-Terryberry room for exhibits and temporary shows.

Application Instructions

All interested parties must email a Resume/CV, Artist Statement, 5-15 images of your work, and an exhibition proposal if applicable to

If you are proposing an exhibition of new art work that has not been created yet, please upload images of art work that are similar in nature to the art work to be exhibited and explain your concept in an exhibition proposal.

Criteria

We consider the following criteria below when reviewing applications as the primary guide for decisions. However, other factors may contribute to final decisions.

- Quality of craftsmanship and content of art work images presented
- Appropriateness of exhibition for the Center and White Lake area
- Relevance to today's global community
- Artworks ability to inspire conversation

Schedule

Deadline to apply online: Monday, October 2, 2017.

Notification to applicants: no later than Saturday, October 17, 2017.

Exhibitions typically are open to the public between five and ten weeks.

Applications considered in this round are for exhibitions that will be scheduled in these available time slots:

Jan/Feb 2018

May/June 2018

Sep/Oct 2018

Important Information

Applicants must be willing to collaborate with an Arts Council Gallery Manager on the execution of their exhibition. Gallery Manager will assist accepted applicants with exhibition concept, selection of art work and layout of the exhibition. Gallery Manager is primarily responsible for installation of the exhibition, however, applicants may propose to handle the installation. Art work to be displayed in the Byam-Terryberry Exhibit Room must be delivered ready to hang or display. It is the responsibility of the artist to cover costs associated with framing or preparation of art work and provide insurance for pieces.

To assist with a small portion of the costs associated with processing

applications, a \$20 application fee is required to be paid with each corresponding application. After application email is received, you will be emailed a Paypal invoice through which you can pay by credit card. If you prefer, you can mail a check (must be postmarked no later than October 1, 2015), payable to ACWL, 106 E Colby Rd., Whitehall, MI, 49461, with the Applicant Name clearly written in the memo line.
