1) Community Grant Application

For White Lake individuals or community groups wanting to provide an arts event for the White Lake community.

2) K-12 Scholarship Application

For students in the White Lake area to be used for instruction in the Fine Arts.

3) Education Grant Application

For schools in the White Lake area for instruction in the Fine Arts. May be used in single or multiple classrooms / schools. Sharing among schools is encouraged. **NOTE:** A change in our policy now allows supplies to be included in the funding if they are necessary to accomplish the event.
